In keeping with Haydn's sense of humor, let's conduct this questionnaire as a game.
Listen over and over to the opening theme (the first 10 seconds) of movement I, the Allegro, until you know it. Or sketch its shape in the margin.
At what 4 later times in movement I do you hear the theme repeated note for note?
At what time or times do you hear a bit of it, but at a higher pitch?
At what time do you hear a bit of it in a minor key?
Next, listen to the opening theme (the first 12 seconds) of movement II, the Scherzo until you know it.
At what 5 later times in movement II do you hear the theme repeated note for note?
Do you ever hear it at another pitch, or in the minor?
Next, listen to the opening theme (the first 30 seconds) of movement III, the slow movement, until you know it.
At what 4 later times in movement III do you hear the theme repeated note for note
Finally, listen to the opening theme (the first 7 seconds) of movement IV, the Finale until you know it.
At what $7\frac{1}{4}$ later times in movement IV do you hear the theme repeated note for note
